## Pedestrians Welcome

The Landmark is a short (2-5 minute) walk from the Oak Bluffs harbor area, and free to enter.

Individual cottages are privately owned, but you may take pictures from the roads and walkways during the day. To view the inside of one of these historic cottages, include a visit to the Cottage Museum, open 7 days per week, in season.

When there are no events, the Tabernacle is open to the public. It remains a place of worship, so all food and beverage should be enjoyed outside of the building.
