2023-2026 Strategic Plan update for leaseholders

MVCMA Committees made progress in 2023 on action items under each of the three goals of the 2023-2026 Strategic Plan. Successes include:

- Goal #1: To cultivate a welcoming faith community for all.
 - Programs provided family and educational programming which included Campfest for children and tent talks on fire safety, historic postcards and spiritual wellness.
 - Long Range Planning developed guidelines for a mentor program for new leaseholders and will introduce it in 2024.
 - Long Range Planning and Communications collaborated to engage with and gather feedback from leaseholders. This activity included six listening sessions in spring 2023 with a report included in the General Manager's May newsletter as well as the introduction of guidelines and resources to expand discussion and collaboration at neighborhood and leaseholder meetings.
- Goal #2: To preserve, nurture and fortify our religious and historical heritage.
 - Historical Preservation & Archives sponsored History Week 2023 which featured 3 speakers, a scavenger hunt, a Prayers for Ukraine event, a tent talk, and a discussion about the Historical Campmeeting Network.
- Goal #3: To be exceptional stewards of MVCMA assets & our National Landmark Status.
 The roof on the Tabernacle is on target for spring 2024 completion.

All other action items remain on schedule for completion.
